Main TSG activities

> LAST TSG1 MEETING

Date and place: 20th TSG1 meeting, 9 December 2024 (Piraeus, Greece -

Hybrid)

Missing countries: Albania, Bosnia & Herzegovina, San Marino (not represented in TSG1). **Main conclusions:** To work further on the better collaboration between the TSG1 members, to the promotion of Pillar 1 activities to the general public, and on the upskilling of blue skills to all those involved or interested on blue economy sectors.

> OTHER TSG1 MEETINGS

Blue Skills for a Sustainable Blue Economy in Adriatic & Ionian Region: Organised in Piraeus at the 10th of December (Hybrid), in collaboration with E. Commission (DGs REGIO & MARE), and under the Auspices of the Hellenic Presidency.

Main conclusions: The need for all those involved with Blue Economy Sectors in the Macro-Region to proceed with the preparation and signing of a Pact for Blue Skills. The TSG1 Chairs were authorised to prepare a draft and facilitate this effort.

Main issues and needs for new AP implementation

Proper representation from the Countries

There is a problem of proper representation from some countries, as the list is not updated (even after the efforts of the Facility Point), or - in some cases - the members from administration are not participating or are not well informed on the needs and priorities of Pillar 1 as they do not work on the relevant issues.

> Work with Pillar Coordinators under their new Role

There is a need for better collaboration, and coordination, on how the Pillar Coordinators will work to promote their Pillar's needs and Action Plan to their TSG Members and to the general public, following the new EUSAIR Governance Architecture Paper.
